We had 12 ladies working in the gathering area selling baked goods and raffle tickets, we also had several more ladies working in the hall helping with breakfast. Thank you so much for all your help. Lastly, thank you to Tom Hakim for once again donating the gift basket, Gary Skarb for the many donated items , and to all others that donated or solicited gifts for the raffle.

Our time schedule should run pretty close to the following:
