VOCATION NEWS

Several months ago, our Vocations Director, Jeff Gapczynski, and our Grand Knight, Bruce Arnold, met with Fr. Ron to discuss a new vocations prayer program. After sharing our ideas, along with input from Fr. Ron, we developed a schedule in which a parish family, who has volunteered in advance, will pray for Vocations.

Each week, on a rotating Mass schedule, the selected family will receive vocations prayer cards and a beautiful statue of the Holy Family to take home. They will be asked to commit themselves to pray throughout the week for additional Sisters, Deacons, Priests, Lay Ministers and married couples. The family will then return the statue and prayer cards to church by Friday, so the next selected family can receive them at the weekend Masses.

Fr. Ron was very much in favor of this program and supported it completely. We will initiate the program the weekend between Christmas and New Years, in honor of Holy Family Week.
